



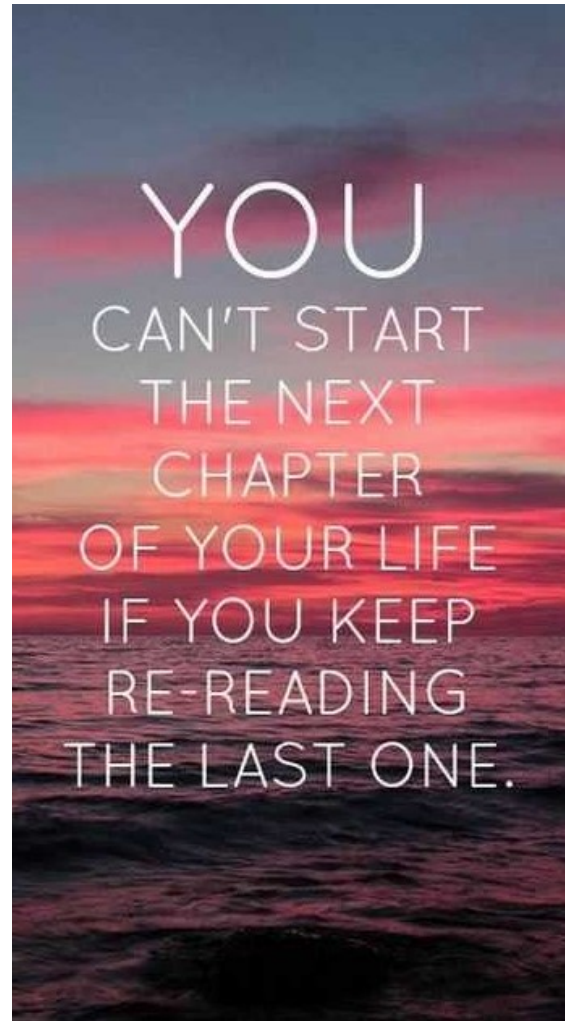
New Chairman Appointed



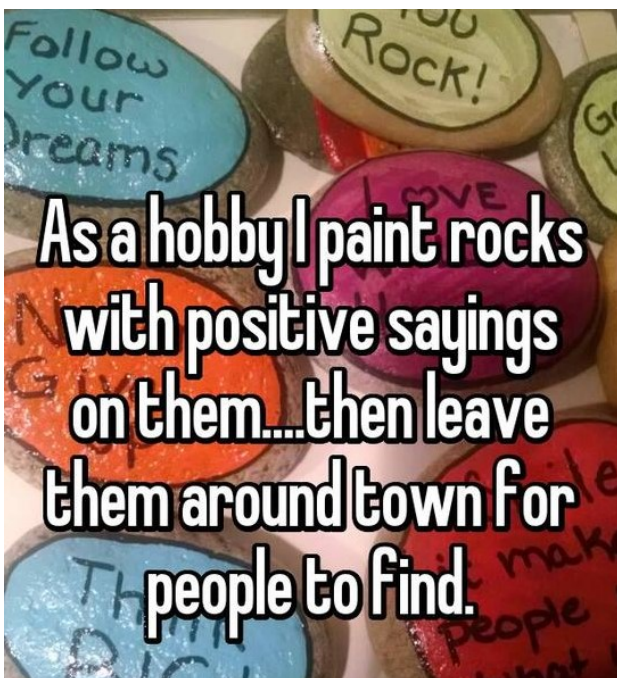
A warm welcome to our new Chairman.
